1	Start in time, plan ahead, ask for help beforehand
2	dont copy and paste
3	-Figure out which one of the help programs for citing sources works for you and use it consistently. -IMing the librarians is a great way to get a quick answer. -If you are on on-campus student, TAKE THE LIBRARY RESEARCH SESSION! It will probably save you a lot of time and stress!!
4	start early and get help
5	Ask for help in locating the best possible sources, dont stick to one source include a wide variety of sources, and work sections at a time on the paper so its not overwhelming
6	Ask a librarian if you need help
7	if they find articles on library' website they can email the sources and save paper. they can ask help from librarians, all of them really helpful.
8	Start early!
9	manage time, I know money is an object now but try and print as much of the material as possible, even copying and pasting the material with all the bibliograph information into an e-mail is always helpful in not losing the source.
10	Start assignments early so you have time to search for sources and think through which ones are most relevant to your assignment. Read articles carefully to consider which, in their actual context, are useful for your assignment. Print out articles for easier reference and keep them organized.
11	Constructing a thorough outline before beginning your paper. Making sure that your thesis is specific enough to be proved within the page limit assigned.
12	Be organized. Be punctual. Clear questions with instructors or with a librarian. Read sources with your goal in mind.
13	Find out about COD library's relationships with other libraries, some can be closer to your home, allow full access to their recources, and have very late hours for days when you are not on COD campus.
14	- Start EARLY. After looking at sources, you may have to alter the thesis or scope of your paper. - Use the downstairs reference section as well as online databases to narrow down your topic, and to locate the best sources for your topic.
15	Read all materials you've researched, then highlight what is important, this will save you time when you start writing.
16	COD library databases are extremely helpful for all types of research research!! (Especially the Academic search premier, and the Expanded Search.) To search for books and other resources, the most helpful would be "keyword" search.
